Parish Meeting 24th April 2018:

Thank you to everyone who attended, helped, provided presentations, reports and food for the Parish Meeting. What a night. There were over 50 members of the public attended and we all enjoyed hearing about our new clubs, the Writers Club, Photography Club and Art Club and seeing examples of the creative skills some of us have within our community. We then received reports from the School, Mendlesham Charities, Mendlesham Community Council, Parish Council, First Responders, FOMSA, Scouts, Explorers, WI, URC and Friends of St Marys illustrating what a diverse community we have with something for everyone of any age or interest. This does not happen without volunteer support and did not include all organisations/ activities operating within the Parish. SCC/MSDC Cllr Andrew Stringer provided his County and District reports and answers to those questions such as repairs to potholes and what is happening about the water running down Old Station Road etc. Andrew also provided the introduction to the Village of the Year Awards - Andrew thank you, it would not be such an enjoyable evening without you.

The winner of the Volunteer Award was Paul Allen. Andrew explained that this was very much overdue and that without Paul, Mendlesham would have lost its Post Office several years ago. Paul has also been a Parish Councillor, including Chairperson and his financial expertise has been greatly appreciated and helped ensure that funds have been available as and when required and placed us in a strong



position to take on the larger projects, such as the expansion of the playingfields project. Paul is also a Trustee of the Mendlesham Charities, has provided support to Mendlesham Football Club, operates the bottle bank scheme providing community funds and is a source of help to many individuals and the community. This is always achieved in a very unassuming manner, indeed all Paul could say on the night was that "he had tried" despite everyone telling him he had succeeded. Thank you Paul.





Val Lawes stood in for Tina today as she is on holiday. She welcomed 47 members to this meeting. We started on a sad note with a minute's silence for Hazel Roe, a former member who has sadly passed away.

Competition schedules were given out for July's flower show and members were urged to start on their crafts.

Our speaker, Mr Stephen Poulter, spoke about Dick Turpin, then told us that an author, Mr Jack Palmer, wrote the book "Rockwood" in the 1800s which glorified Dick Turpin as being a handsome, well dressed robber and romanticized him. There were films and TV series of him. at which point I thought I was pretty thick because I always believed he was real! However, then he continued to tell us about the real Turpin who was a very unsavoury person. He was a butcher and started rustling cattle to make money. He went on to torture and terrorise people in their own homes to relieve them of their treasures and money. He unfortunately misjudged his aim and killed his partner in crime. Rewards were put up for his capture and he was finally traced by his handwriting, which was recognised by his former teacher. He was caught with stolen horses and sentenced to hang. Apparently horses seem to have been more important than human life and robbery, so he was not the hero portrayed in the books and he never rode Black Bess to her death to get to York.

MENDLESHAM WI

A wonderful warm evening greeted the members of Mendlesham WI at the April meeting.

The speaker for the evening was a jovial man from The River Gipping Trust Ltd, Mr Gerry Crease - Trustee

Their mission is to preserve the 17 miles of historic heritage of the Ipswich and Stowupland navigation. To you and I its the river Gipping we know from Stowmarket to Ipswich, you can see parts of it on the A14 as you drive to Ipswich on the right. Did you know the River Gipping rises in Mendlesham? Using slides, Mr. Crease took us on a trip along the River Gipping, from Stowmarket to Ipswich.

The main focus of the group at the moment is to get the section at Pipps Ford cleared and the Locks repaired allowing for the free flow of water. The other project is the foot path between the Locks at Baylham and Creeting, clearing and maintaining it for walkers to enjoy unheeded.

The canal was opened in 1798 and made redundant when the railway came; the last commercial barge sailing in 1900. Historically the waterway was part of the main navigation from Stowmarket to London via Ipswich, used to transport cargo, barges were charged per tonnage that they carried, it took 12 hours down at 1/2 penny per ton but up stream 18 hours 1 penny per ton. But if they picked up Night soil from London it travelled free!

12 of our members competed in the triennial Upper Waveney Exhibition at Hempnall with very commendable results. Beryl Clark was awarded a trophy for her limerick about the Broads.

We were proud to read about Joan Hill, one of our members in the Let's Talk publication telling of her love of singing and of the WI Denman College in Oxfordshire.

The competition was for a photograph of a river. Competition results = 1st Jill Baker, 2nd Shirley Furze, 3rd Enid Lambert.

Our next meeting will be on the 19th June the speaker is David Webb talking about his life as a "Hi De Hi" yellow coat. Meeting starts at 7.30pm in the Mendlesham Community Centre Small Hall.

By now many of you will have been contacted by companies and organisations, explaining about the new statutory regulations from 25th May 2018 and asking for your consent to process and hold your personnel data.

Personal Information includes your name, address, phone number, email address, IP address, cookie records and correspondence. It does not cover business related information.

Email Address

It does not include Councillors contact details as they are public officers, Business contact details and correspondence, Charity or Community Group officer/secretary contact details and correspondence.

As a Parish Council and Trustee of two charities, Mendlesham Community Centre and Mendlesham Playingfields, we have no choice but to change the way we work and communicate with yourselves. Some of you will be receiving individual correspondence, sometimes for more than one subject and be asked to confirm that we are able to hold your data for a particular reason or advised we are legally holding your data and why/how long. For some data now held automatically, for example if you email us in a personal capacity, we will now have to delete your email address or obtain your express consent to hold and use it. Those of you on E news will be asked to update your subscription details and if you decide not to, will be removed from the mailing list. For those of you who have been registered as a Parish Council volunteer, either for snow clearing, grass cutting, woodland work or anything else, we now need to start again with a new Mendlesham Volunteer List- more information will be available shortly via E News and in the next Newsletter. However it is important to note if you do not register as a new volunteer you will not be covered under the Parish Council insurance as a parish council volunteer or Suffolk County Council insurance for snow clearing. All personal information regarding previous volunteers will be deleted by the end of May.

At the time of writing this is very much a work in progress and we will do our best to make this administratively easy for us all as possible. It would be very much appreciated if you could also help us in this work. Thank you,

Pooling Resources!

Michael was a very dear friend for many years, whose company we valued greatly. I first knew the family through his father, who was Moderator to the Congregational Churches in Yorkshire, to whom I turned when first sensing a call to become a minister.

I then came across Michael a good many years later when I was appointed a minister in the South Leeds Team Ministry. I discovered he was a person of many talents, especially the fact that he was an excellent Chef – in fact he was employed at Armley Jail responsible for feeding the staff each day. But he also put this talent to good use by fund-raising for a choir he was heavily involved in. This involved taking over someone's kitchen and providing a meal for their invited guests, who made a contribution towards the work of the choir that, in the end, gained an international reputation.

To this end, Jayne and myself would be invited round to his home a few weeks before one of these events, and he would 'experiment' with us so that he could test out his menus before taking it 'on the road'. We didn't mind being guinea pigs as his meals were excellent and of an extremely high standard – the only downside was that we had to offer 'constructive criticism' so that he could gauge what modifications might be deemed necessary (but he knew that I was no Mary Berry!!)

After enjoying their gourmet cooking on numerous occasions, we felt it only right that we should extend an invitation to come to our home for a meal. I was on dessert duty, and chose a bread and butter puddling – and expressed amazement at the transformation that had taken place courtesy of the oven. We clearly couldn't achieve anywhere near the standards that Michael had produced, but what we offered was out of a deep sense of love and gratitude for his friendship. Nervously we watched him eat, and somewhat relieved that he graciously complimented us on our efforts.

As well as being an excellent cook, Michael was also blessed with a musical gift, both playing the piano and composing music. For myself I could strum a guitar of sorts, and have been known to play a comb wrapped in paper, but the one thing that I could offer was to sing – and we were able to combine our talents to good effect for the enrichment of ourselves, as well as the many audiences we entertained.

When I was invited by a Churches Together Group in Leeds to lead a session on 'Temptation' for their Lent Study, I wrote a dialogue that began in the Garden of Eden, and concluded with a meditation on the Cross where Jesus said: 'My God, My God, why have You abandoned Me?!' (Matthew 27: 46), I eagerly turned to Michael and explained that I wanted music to link the various sections and hold it all together – and he didn't disappoint, offering music that complimented the dialogue so that the presentation spoke to people at different levels..

It is a timely reminder as we celebrate the gifts of the Holy Spirit to the Church, that the Apostle Paul affirms that there are variety of skills and talents, which are distributed in different degrees of ability, but each have been given to achieve a purpose in life and to be a blessing. This is what he wrote to the Church in Corinth:

'There are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are varieties of service, but the same Lord. There are varieties of activity, but in all of them and in everyone the same God is active. In each of us the Spirit is seen to be at work for some useful purpose. But all these gifts are the activity of the one and the same Spirit, distributing them to each individual at will. [1 Corinthians 12: 4 – 11 (part) REB]

Elsewhere he insists that these gifts are meant to be given equal status – no one gift is more important than the other – and that they should be shared for the benefit of all. It is only when gifts and talents are pooled that we can begin to achieve much in the service of our Lord.



Fr Philip Writes...

"This is what I received from the Lord and in turn passed on to you..."

The feast of Corpus Christi is a day of thanksgiving for Holy Communion. When we celebrate the Mass Christ is present in a special way and we re-enact the death by which he saved us. One of the Gospels appointed for Corpus Christi (Luke 9 v 11-17) gives the feeding

of the 5,000 a Eucharistic significance, for Luke uses the same words at the Last Supper and the Emmaus story: "Jesus took bread... blessed... broke... and gave." At every Mass the Church continues the mission of Jesus to touch, heal and feed the people of God. On the first



day of the week - the day of Jesus' Resurrection - the early Christians met to break bread - and from that day to our own the Mass has been the centre of the Church's life. We are the new people of God and Jesus is in our midst when we hear his voice in the scriptures. These words are not dead but living words to inspire and challenge us. Then we are nourished by food – the Body and Blood of Christ. Jesus said, "Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you shall not have life in you." (John 6 v 53) At the end of the Mass of Corpus



Christi we have a Procession of the Blessed Sacrament to remind us we are sent out as bearers of Christ's life to others. At Mass we are able to enter into deep intimacy with Jesus in Holy Communion. It helps us to live as Jesus lived, willing to go out to others.

The month of June is dedicated to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**. The heart

symbolises God's love which is free and cannot be forced – and by loving us so completely, God takes the risk that this love may not be received. God offers us the gifts of forgiveness and mercy, but for some mysterious reason we find it hard to receive, probably because we want to control our lives and hold on to the reins and put ourselves in the centre.

50 years ago some Belgian divers discovered the wreck of the Spanish warship 'Girona' off the coast of Ireland which sank at the time of the Armada. One of the treasures they found was a man's wedding ring with a human hand



clutching a heart. Etched on the gold band was a hand holding a heart. Around the ring was a moving inscription in Spanish: 'No Tengo Mas Que Darte' ... "I HAVE NOTHING MORE TO GIVE YOU." Jesus on the Cross gave us everything he had.... He, too had nothing more to give us.
