
The June meeting is on the Tuesday, 4th at 7.30pm in the Old School Room.

MENDLESHAM COOKING CLUB 2018/19

Over the past year numbers for the cooking club have steadily increased, February 2019 session saw 42 children attend during the cold winter ½ term, with 58 children attending the Easter cooking club sessions. We only run 8 sessions each year, with 3 in the summer, the last session being the annual picnic, where parents, & family are invited to join us.

It is rewarding to see how the children grow in confidence, socialising with children from outside of their normal circle of friends, and also learning some basic math's to calculate ingredients for the set recipes. As always it is the army of volunteers from the village that make the cooking club possible. I can do all of the background work, but it is the volunteers that help out in the kitchen (not a pleasant task!!) and those that help out on the tables with the children to produce the food, which makes the cooking club a success.

The cooking club was initially set up to offer something different to the children and also make use of the small hall during the holiday periods, it was never intended to be run for profit. However since starting, it has been self-funded, purchasing all necessary equipment and ingredients needed out of money paid by parents. Since summer 2018 to Easter 2019, the cooking club has given back to the Community Council £359.97 after the hall hire charges have been paid.

I am pleased to see that something that started out as a 1 off has now grown to be a regular fixture on the Community Council calendar. I was rather pleased when one Mum, who only started coming last October **praised me** for how well organised the cooking club is, and how **well behaved the children are**, and that I have all Risk Assessments and Food Safety requirements in place. The Mum concerned then explained that she is a Primary School Ofstead Inspector and she wished all school activities were as efficiently run as the Mendlesham Cooking Club. A small comment like that, makes all the hard work worthwhile.

The Community Council had a very successful day despite the cold weather. Those that came reported they had a great time. Those providing food WI, Scouts, Toddler Group and Church made more money than last year. Other organisations have also said they had a good day. We heard from so many visitors how much they enjoy the Fayre.

I would like to thank the people who sponsored us; Tramspread; Galloway; DJ Howlett Motor Engineers; Jaiger Engineering; Bluesky; 3 Point Property Management; Ince Development Ltd; Baronia; M L Property Consultants & Classic Stoves. Also thanks to Acorn Kennels and Brian Palmer Haulage who sponsored our Grand Draw and thanks to Brian for delivery of the trailer for our stage. Your support helped make the day a success.

REPORT BY CHAIR OF MENDLESHAM PARISH COUNCIL Cllr Mike Exley

At first thought, this year seems to have been dominated by the need to consider planning applications -some which will/would have significant impact. Mid Suffolk have had, seemed to have lost and then found a five year land supply, all in the same year. This is an important factor when all of the planning considerations are weighed up and decisions made.

The need for this work is likely to continue and all we can do locally is to continue to make detailed representation either as a Parish Council or as individual residents providing comments directly to MSDC, the Planning Authority and decision maker.

We also continue to work on the revision of our Neighbourhood Plan, in anticipation that by allocating specific sites for future growth, we will provide clarity with a legal status, to determine how and where any growth should be in the future. The reliance on the importance of MSDC having a five year supply should then, based on current legislation, be less relevant for Mendlesham.

You may recall a consultation some 18 months ago now, which provided valuable community thoughts on where and when future development should happen. Our local thoughts at that time and since have been very clear. We need to take into consideration the current pressures on our road structure, the amount and type of traffic passing through our conservation area now and the need to mitigate what can be done to prevent and hopefully lessen volumes of traffic through this area. Development has to be in the right place, the right time and contribute towards our community well being.

We then received belated advice that for a robust legal plan, we needed professional help to assess the suitability of the different land site options. This additional information will decrease the possibility of a legal challenge against our plan in the future. After obtaining grant funding, national and Locality* from Mid Suffolk District Council and Suffolk County Council, we have commissioned a Site Assessment report, a Strategic Environment Assessment report, a Historic Environment report and Traffic surveys detailing volumes and type of traffic through Mendlesham village. We also commissioned a Housing Needs Survey.

Most of this information has now been received with the remainder due imminently. We now need to assess this and decide the way forward. It is likely that we will have to consult with you again on this, but please be patient and support us in this vital work.

Playingfields:

We are pleased to report that we have three new pieces of equipment at Mendlesham Green, a nest swing, roundabout and climbing complex. This work was paid for with £10,000 from Parish Council Funds, £500 Mendlesham Education Foundation, £2,000 Mendlesham Community Council, £2500 SCC Locality grant* and £7201 MSDC Capital Grant. Thank you.

Work on the project at the Mendlesham Playingfields continues further to the S106 monies available from Station Fields and we hope to be in a position very shortly to agree and commence the first works.

Community Centre:

Working in partnership with the school, the building has benefited from an improved fire system, new internal doors, external cladding, guttering and redecoration of the Main Hall, the stage lights now all work. The Small Hall also now has a new sound system and projector- thank you to Mendlesham Community Council who provided the idea and majority of the funds. New doors been provided for the Small Hall from Mendlesham Parish Council funds.

Whilst the majority of this work has been at no or little cost to Mendlesham Community Centre Charity, our overheads have increased outside our control, particularly utility costs.

After much consideration, we have reviewed our charging system and increased fees from 1st September. This is necessary to keep the building available and to the required standard. Whilst we were able to keep the hire fees the same since 2016, we now have to increase fees from September and will review this annually, increasing as a minimum by inflation.

We have also taken the opportunity to review our hire fee structure to make the arrangements fair and transparent for all and hope to attract new hire, particularly over weekends and school holidays.

We have received a £3000 MSDC Locality* grant towards the provision of LED lights with decisions about where and when to be made shortly. We have also reviewed our other utility costs to ensure we keep costs to a minimum and will be reviewing cleaning arrangements as well.

Mendlesham Green telephone box: thank you to everyone who has helped. We now have a refurbished red telephone box containing a defibrillator at Mendlesham Green. This was funded by Mendlesham Parish Council.

Other work: The Battles Over Remembrance event at Mendlesham Green, arrangements to comply with new data protection legislation, GDPR, provision of a new noticeboard (still to be installed) near Station Fields with the help of a grant from Lovells, continued conversations about Rights of Way and Planning Enforcement issues with officers have also helped keep everyone busy.

Future:

So what next?

We have an election for Parish Councillors. The first in 16 years. There has been much interest from residents about becoming more involved in community life. This can only be positive for the parish. We should also have all 11 Councillor positions filled for the first time in four years.

We have researched and made the decision to set up a Community Land Trust which will be the legal vehicle enabling us to own our own community housing for perpetuity. This is at an early stage and will require community support. Whilst there are other parishes already doing this in Suffolk and Essex, this is another first for Mendlesham and Mid Suffolk District Council who are providing a £4,000 grant and support to help us set this up. More information when known.

The Neighbourhood Plan/Planning work, Mendlesham Playingfield Project and Community Centre work will also continue. So plenty to do, without anything else new Cllrs or events may bring.

Community:

We have some wonderful organisations in Mendlesham, looking after the young, older residents, the religious needs of our community and providing sporting, educational and social activities. Many other individuals are also just quietly doing their bit for the community. You know who you are, your work is much appreciated Thank you.

Parish Councillors, I would like to say thank you for the valuable and often unseen and unsung work that you do.

* Please note whilst we were unable to say at the Parish Meeting due to the forthcoming election, thank you to Cllr Stringer for the locality grants mentioned in this report as well as the organisation of the recent Mendlesham Street Litter pick.







"All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them." (Acts 2 verse 4)

As a nation there is one thing that is a constant topic of conversation (and it's not Brexit!), it is the weather. We may complain about our weather but there is something comforting about our seasons. There is always something to say, to see and to wonder at. Conversations can range from it being too hot to too cold or from drought conditions to floods. We see the effect different conditions have on our gardens and how the different seasons bring different flowers. Where the bare brown ground of winter springs into life with green shoots and the awesome sight of the vast array of flowers and vegetables that result. Then there is always the wonder.... Although, after the summer conditions of Easter and the frosty nights of May we may not always know when to expect each type of weather! But, in general, we can be sure that spring will follow winter, summer will follow spring and autumn will follow summer.

Just like the weather, Christian seasons are to be talked about, to be seen and to wonder at. At Christmas there is joy for the birth of a new born baby, our Lord Jesus Christ. At Easter we have the heart wrenching scenes of our Lord on the cross, but then the amazing truth of the resurrection. As we enter

June our thoughts may turn to summer, but our thoughts also turn to another season in our Christian life. Sunday June 9th is the 7th Sunday after Easter, Pentecost or Whit Sunday, where we celebrate the Holy Spirit descending on Jesus' disciples.

After the overwhelming drama of Easter Pentecost can sometimes feel like a minor event, but it is a key moment in our Christian Faith. The Holy Spirit had been with the world from the beginning...first mentioned in Genesis 1 verse "And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters." But here at Pentecost we see it now revealed in a different manner. The Holy Spirit is completely revealed because of what Christ had done for us. At Pentecost, something was set in motion that is still reverberating today. For us, of the Christian tradition, this event also represents the birth of the early Church.

Then, move on a week and we come to Sunday June 16th which is Trinity Sunday...one to get your head around...in my Christian life I've heard so many explanations of the Trinity but it still causes confusion of thought...God the Father...God the Son...God the Holy Ghost....wow what a concept, something to really wonder about in all senses of the word.

Whatever you are doing this June take time to speak of your faith; to look at the works of God; and to wonder at God's love for all.



Fr Philip Writes...


June is a month of festivals – Ascension Sunday (2nd June), the birthday of the Church at Whitsun, or Pentecost (9th June), the Most

Holy Trinity (16th June), Corpus Christi (23rd June) and Saints Peter & Paul (29th June). All these days call us to do great things for God.

Very often people who are keen to push themselves forward are likely to do people more harm than good, because they rely on their own reserves and seek their own glory. When we acknowledge our emptiness, God can fill us and he accomplishes in us the things



we find difficult or impossible. However, it is so easy to use our sins and weaknesses as a cop-out. St Paul said, "Of all the apostles I am the least;" I don't even deserve the name 'Apostle'." (1 Corinthians 15 v 9).



St Peter said, "Leave me, Lord, I am a sinful man." (Luke 5 v 8) When we act like Peter we are giving into our sinfulness.

But who did Jesus come for? He came

for sinners and changed people's understanding of God. God is not someone who shuns sinners but wants them to be saved and given a new start. Paul and Peter eventually accepted God's invitation and this is the paradox: strength comes from weakness. When we answer God's call he empowers us with the Holy Spirit so we can do things we never thought possible. "There are no impossible situations – only those who have become impossible about them."

We all need someone to accept us for what we are, who believes we are capable of more and challenges us to realise it. I want us all to ponder the word **FAITH:**

Please apply this to yourselves, for God has plans for you.

We all need to ask ourselves:

Am I willing to accept God's forgiveness?

We need to abandon our self-sufficiency and to recognise the need to be touched by God, who will take us out of ourselves. One of the mysteries of life is the tremendous respect that God



accords to human free will. He never forces us to change but invites us to open our hearts to his power. The question is: **Will we?**
