Parish Council:

Dog poo

Fully appreciate this is a cause of concern and distress throughout the Parish, but the residents of Mill Road, Mendlesham, in particular are experiencing issues with owners allowing their dogs to defecate on their gardens.

As well as being an eyesore and a nuisance, on most public land it is an offence under the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 not to clear up after your dog after it has fouled. MSDC has powers to issue 'on the spot' Fixed Penalty Notices of £50, or to prosecute in the criminal courts, which could lead to a fine of up to £1,000. Dog fouling should be wrapped and disposed of in one of our many dog or litter bins or by placing it in your black wheelie bin.

If you see someone failing to clean up after their dog in a public place then try to remember and note down as much detail of the incident as possible, including the date, time and location, and the name and address of the offender if you know it. Where a vehicle is involved please note the make, colour and registration mark of the vehicle, together with a description of the person. Please then report them via

Parish Council Elections:

We now have further information about the arrangements for nominations for the Election on 2nd May.

The deadline for delivery of nominations papers which must be hand delivered to a member of the Electoral Services, MSDC is Wednesday 3rd April 4pm. Between 12th and 19th March, this is possible locally at either Stowmarket or Eye, but thereafter nominations need to be taken to Endeavour House, Ipswich.

The Parish Clerk has nomination papers or if preferred they can also be obtained from:

elections@baberghmidsuffolk.gov.uk. Tel 01449 724684

Please remember the importance of of these elections and the work the Parish Council undertakes on your behalf. Please do not assume either existing Councillors or others will stand.

To be eligible to stand for Mendlesham Parish Council you need to:

- Be a UK or Commonwealth citizen; or be a citizen of the Republic of Ireland; or be a citizen of another Member State of the European Union
- Be at least 18 years old
- Be an elector of Mendlesham Parish Council; or in the past 12 months occupied land or other premises in the area the Mendlesham Parish Council serves (as owner or tenant); or work in the area Mendlesham Parish Council serves (as your principal or only place of work); or live within three miles of the Parish Council boundary.
- Not be disqualified under section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972 or section 34 of the Localism Act 2011 (further details available on request, but includes bankruptcy and criminally convicted for a period of not less than three months without the option of a fine)
- Mendlesham Parish Council welcome and are committed to the inclusion and recognition of all regardless of race, culture, ability, ethnicity or gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, marital status, religious affiliation, and socioeconomic status

Ideally we would have more than 11 candidates stand which would then prompt a balloted election - thus promoting democracy and providing a clear mandate for the new Council.

It is also essential that Mendlesham can continue to hold something called the Power of Competency. This has various requirements, but includes the need for eight Mendlesham parish councillors minimum to be elected in May.

Please do not hesitate to speak to a Parish Councillor or the Clerk as required or come along on Saturday 9th March to the Small Hall, Mendlesham Community Centre between 10.30- noon to find out more about how you can make a difference.

What is important is that we each have a grasp of our Christian beliefs and can share our hope with others. By March I hope gardens and the countryside will be springing to life with flowers and birdsong, so we remember Jesus' journey to the cross of Calvary was followed by his glorious resurrection from the dead. Lent can be an opportunity to meet with Jesus in a new way and experience his resurrection power at a deeper level.

If you are not a regular churchgoer but wish to find out more, all of our churches offer a welcome both at Sunday services and gatherings during the week.

Fr Philip Writes...

Lent begins in March this year. The word 'Lent' comes from an old English

word meaning 'Springtime' and is observed at this time of the year when days begin to get longer. As there is new life in nature during Spring, it also reminds us of spring cleaning. Lent is a time of spiritual cleaning in our lives and we do this through repentance and reconciliation. Lent begins on **Ash Wednesday**—so called because of the ashes (made from last year's Palm Crosses) placed on our foreheads to show we are sorry about our wrongdoing and serious about wanting to overcome sin.



So often the only thing people seem to know about Lent is 'giving up something' without knowing why. The story is told of a priest returning one evening to his Rectory in the dark. He was accosted by a robber who pulled out a gun, pointed it at him and demanded, "Your money or your life!" As the priest reached his hand into his coat pocket, the robber saw his clerical collar and said, "So you're a priest? Then you can go."

The priest was rather surprised at this unexpected show of piety and so tried to reciprocate by offering the robber his packet of cigarettes, but the robber replied, "No, Father, I've given up smoking for Lent!"

The robber was trying to keep an outward show of not smoking in Lent whilst forgetting the far more fundamental commandment not to steal.

The ashes on Ash Wednesday are a sign of repentance of the change of heart we want to achieve so we become closer to God. Of course we can 'do penance' or show repentance by giving up our favourite foods, as Fasting is one of the 3 hallmarks of Lent which Our Lord encourages us to do. But we don't give up luxuries like chocolate, for instance, just so we can binge on Easter Eggs 6 weeks later. **Fasting** should go

hand-in-hand with the other two: Almsgiving and Prayer.

i. <u>'Almsgiving'</u> means giving away money, including the savings made on those luxuries - to deserving people or charities. When we give money away we are demonstrating the love of God and love of our fellow human beings. This year we are encouraged to support the diocese of Kagera, a beautiful region in

Tanzania, where the majority of its 1 million inhabitants live on less than £1 per day, mostly through subsistence farming. Parts of Kagera have some of the




highest under-five mortality rates in the country. Lack of education and low capital investment in the area has led to a perception of poverty being the norm and to a dependency on external aid. As well as being twinned with our diocese, there is a closer link. In 2011 on a visit to Suffolk, Bishop Darlington, when a parish priest, joined us with his wife Emelia at a healing service at

Mendlesham and on pilgrimage to Walsingham. His diocese serves communities through spiritual nurture, healthcare, education and poverty alleviation. Please give generously.

ii. <u>Prayer</u>. By prayer we grow closer to Christ, but it is far more important to listen to God than just talk to him. Two of the best ways are by listening to and reading God's Word in the Bible and receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion. We pray, too, for our brothers and sisters in Christ in Kagera.

Lent should not be a miserable time. It invites me to ask: How enthusiastically do I follow Jesus? Where does my enthusiasm come from? and What keeps my enthusiasm going? Let us all embrace these challenges wholeheartedly.
