From September 7th our sessions are on Tuesday mornings from 9am to 10.15am, with the opportunity to purchase tea and coffee from the bar afterwards for anyone who has the time to stay for a chat. A session costs £5 and they are normally run by our professional coach, Jo Hughes, who was the club's founding member and gives us group and individual coaching (all included in the price!!!) in an encouraging and positive manner.

We provide feather shuttlecocks (better than plastic ones) and can lend new players a racquet, making it really easy for anyone to come along and see how they like it.

We welcome new members: so, whether you or are a beginner, experienced player or fancy getting back into badminton after a break, this a highly enjoyable and sociable way of making new friends, and improving wellbeing and fitness. It would be lovely to see you.

I'm a single parent and lost my job during the pandemic. My local Citizens Advice helped me apply for Universal Credit which has been really helpful to cover some of the income I've lost. But I'm very worried about the upcoming £20-a-week cut to Universal Credit, particularly with ongoing school costs - is there any other support out there to help plug the gap?

If you're on a low income or unemployed, you might be able to get help with some of the costs of sending your child to school, including school meals, transport and uniform. It's always worth talking to your local education authority to see what support is available as some of their resources and offerings can differ.

#### Free school meals

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 automatically get free school meals. If you have older children you can apply for free school meals if you get certain benefits. In your case as you're on Universal Credit and you applied after 1 April 2018 you would be eligible if you earn less than £7,400 a year without benefits. You can see the full list of eligibility requirements on the national Citizens Advice website – just go to citizensadvice.org.uk and search "school meals" on the site.

#### **Transport**

If your children are aged between five to 16, your local education authority might offer free or lower cost transport if you don't live near school or your child's unable to walk there. You need to apply to Suffolk County Council for help.

#### Uniforms and other costs

Suffolk County Council might also be able to help with some other costs, like uniforms, music lessons or trips and activities. There may also be local charitable schemes to help with these costs, it's worth checking with the school to see if it knows of any. Schools can also sometimes advise on finding secondhand uniforms.

#### If it gets too much

If you are starting to fall behind on your bills, then Citizens Advice can help. Our Advisers can look at your budget to see if we can help you save money and check that you're claiming everything that you're entitled to.

## Performances of Fauré's Requiem and Handel's Messiah by Stowmarket Chorale

As a choir we are very much looking forward to singing in front of an audience again at the two concerts we have planned for this November. Our chosen venue for both concerts is the United Reform Church, Ipswich Road, Stowmarket where we have often sung in the past. We will be observing all current Covid guidelines.

The works which we will be performing are the Fauré Requiem and John Ireland's Greater Love Hath No Man, on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November and Handel's Messiah on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> November, both at 7.30 p.m. The cost of the tickets will be £15 per concert. (Students and children under 16 may attend for free). If you would like to attend both concerts, there will be a £5 reduction overall, i.e. a cost of £25.

We have kept busy during Covid times with Zoom singing sessions and recently with two singing days in Elmswell where we practised the concert pieces.

We are returning to weekly evening live rehearsals at Stowmarket United Reform Church from Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> September.

It would be lovely if readers were interested in attending either or both of our concerts. Parking at the URC is limited and restricted to people with disabilities. However, there are several carparks nearby.



At this time of Year our thoughts in Church turn to our Harvest services, but have you ever thought where our Harvest services come from? Even though we can trace Harvest Thanksgiving back to Greek, Roman and even early Jewish times, within church history it is relatively modern.

It was in Morwenstow, a village on the north coast of Cornwall. In September 1843 it's vicar the Reverend Robert Stephen Hawker, announced, 'God has been very merciful to us this year. He hath filled our garners with increase, and satisfied our poor with bread. . . Let us offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving.'

This was the start of what we now think of as the traditional British Harvest Festival. Victorian hymns such as 'We plough the fields and scatter', 'Come, ye thankful people, come' and 'All things bright and beautiful' helped popularise his idea of harvest thanksgiving, and the custom of decorating churches with local produce became widespread.

Church goers would often spend a great deal of time decorating their churches. Apples are arranged along window sills; bunches of grapes are hung from unlikely places, while bunches of wheat or barley are made. There are often displays of specially made loaves, trays of eggs and bunches of flowers — even, these days, tinned food.

Each gift represents a 'thank you' for food that has grown during the summer and which will keep the population fed during the coming winter.

In some seaside churches, fishermen bring some of their catch to be part of the thanksgiving. In others, coal miners used to offer the coal they had dug from deep in the earth:

Harvest is, after all, a thanksgiving for all the 'fruits' of the earth. When the festival is over, the food is either given away to those in need or sold and the money given to the poor in this or other countries. Any flowers would have been sent to local hospitals.

Harvest-time is actually one of the world's oldest festivals and was celebrated by the Ancient Greeks, who gave thanks to Demeter the goddess of agriculture, and by the Romans, who called her Ceres.

The Jewish people have celebrated harvest or Sukkot (the Feast of the Tabernacles) for over 3,000 years.

Although the Christian harvest festival may be comparatively modern in origin, the celebration of the harvest in Britain pre-dates Christianity.

Farmers would offer the first cut sheaf of corn to one of their fertility gods, in the hope of receiving a good harvest. when the last sheaf to be cut (at the end of the harvest) was thought to contain the Spirit of the Corn, and its cutting was usually accompanied by the ritual sacrifice of an animal — sometimes a hare caught hiding in the corn. Later, the sacrificial animal was replaced by a model hare made from straw — a custom that led to the plaiting of 'corn dollies' which were hung in farmhouses until the following year.

The horse bringing home the last cartload of corn was decorated with garlands of flowers and colourful ribbons.

In the days when farming was a largely unmechanized industry, harvesting was a long and tiring job — and often a battle against the weather.

Consequently, its completion was an occasion for much feasting. When the harvest was 'safely gathered in', a celebratory supper was held to which the whole community was invited. For many of the farm workers, this meal, known as the 'harvest-home', was the biggest and best meal of the year until Christmas. The custom survives in the harvest suppers still held in many of our communities today.

However you plan to celebrate harvest have a good one.


