Proud to be in our Parish

The tall man who daily walks round the parish who is seldom seen without his cine-camera is **Geoff Clarke**.

Geoff, his wife, Meg, plus Gemma, youngest of three daughters, moved to Mendlesham in 2006 from Haughley. His family maintain that he has film and sound recording running through his veins.

Born in Doncaster in the middle of WW2, Geoff relocated to Norwich in 1947 with his parents and two siblings. He was attracted to the sounds and images of the cinema as a schoolboy and was frequently summoned by teachers to present 16mm films as they struggled with the technology. Schooling offered no joy for Geoff as he battled with undiagnosed Dyslexia and poor eyesight. Employment in Electro-finishing and Motor Vehicle Technology were soon abandoned as the cinema industry proved irresistible. After training in electrical maintenance with VEH Cinemas as a projectionist Geoff became Chief Operator/Manager at The Regal Cinema in Stowmarket at the age of twenty.

A slump in the cinema industry in 1963 resulted in a move to Eastern Electricity as a Craftsman Electrical Fitter in Telecommunications for thirty years. Geoff never abandoned his interest in film. He maintained connections with The Regal Cinema showing films evenings and weekends and became a film presenter for the East Anglian Film Archive based at the University of East Anglia going on to work part-time as a Technical Manager and Assistant Archivist responsible for film restoration and printing. He designed for manufacture a device for printing 17.5mm film, worked with media students, showed films at Ipswich Corn Exchange and Cambridge Arts Theatre and collaborated with the producers of ITV's 'The Way We Were' series. He remained involved on a voluntary basis after retirement.

Geoff was also a Recorder for the Suffolk Local History Council using film as a medium for recording village events. This led to a publication in 1989, in collaboration with others, of 'The Haughley Photographic Collection, Past and Present' and in 2005 'The Book of Haughley,' featuring many of his photographs. During twenty-eight years in Haughley Geoff also found time to serve fifteen years on the Parish Council, some of the term as Chairman!

A lover of classical music and member of the Stowmarket Choral Society, Geoff sang in solo roles at home and abroad as well as being the official photographer and concert recordist. This interest in sound recording led to his role as Trustee and Chairman of the Cotton Mechanical Music Museum and Bygones from 1983 until its closure in 2017.

Geoff continued the voluntary role as Parish Recorder in Mendlesham. Video-recording is now his preferred medium capturing changes and events and presenting an annual Newsreel for public presentation. Naturally he helped set up the Film Nights in the small hall until its recent closure.

He enjoys being part of Mendlesham Bowls Club and walking and cycling.

Geoff, we are proud to have you in our parish.

Thank you to all involved.

We now have a new green grit bin at the corner of Church Road and Brockford Road Mendlesham which replaces the damaged old bin.

The Mendlesham Green parish noticeboard, previously located at the Bus Shelter at the Scout Site has now been rejuvenated and situated at the entrance to Mendlesham Green playingfields. We hope this will be a better location, for more to visit.

An order has been placed for the village sign at Mendlesham to be re coated. This will not happen for some months but we are on the waiting list.

A review is currently taking place regarding the location of our litter bins, some minor changes will be made, including where necessary replacement.

The condition and potential need to clean the USA 34th Bomb Memorial, located in the churchyard at St Mary's Church Mendlesham has been raised and researched. Confirmation has been received that no actions are required and all is as it should be.

Mendlesham Playingfields:

With thanks to George Yardley, who has volunteered and been appointed to co ordinate hire for Mendlesham Playingfields and the MUGA.

George can be contacted via email playingfields@mendleshampc.org and we would hope that the majority of you will be able to contact him this way. However, if any one cannot, please telephone the Parish Clerk, who will then pass on contact details for George to contact you by telephone accordingly. Playingfield hire fees had been suspended over the summer, whilst village organisations felt more comfortable meeting outside and as a community, it was really important to help the community make steps towards being able to meet again.

From 1st September 2021, playingfield fees will be levied as before, £50 per match to play on the Parish Council owned football pitch which will be white lined, everywhere else, all users, including football users to arrange whitelining of the other pitches themselves, £10 per hour with the 4th hour free.

The Muga is now available for private hire. Fee £20 per hour plus £5 per hour lighting as required. Please note at times the MUGA will be locked and not available for general use. This will be preceding a private hire, the need to prevent damage to the surface, or for maintenance works.

Young people raise almost £1000 for their new scout hut

Two members of 1st Mendlesham Scout Group have raise nearly £1000 between them in aid of a new scout hut for 1st Mendlesham Scouts.

George Skilling age 11, who attends scouts, and Robert Sharpe age 8, who attends Cubs, took part in a sponsored bike/hike during June to support the fundraising efforts of the Scout group, who need to raise £250,000 to build a new scout hut in Mendlesham Green.

George raised £300 by completing a cycle ride with the rest of his scout troop during their weekly section meeting. He completed a 12 mile route, starting and finishing at the scout field in Mendlesham Green and took in places such as Cotton, Old Newton and cycling off road along Swill Tub Lane, Hundred Lane and Middy Railway. This was part of his personal challenge to complete 50 miles.

Robert raised £600.50 by completing a 10.2 mile hike, starting at Little Stonham and ending up at Barham where his grandparents live, taking in Stonham Aspal, Coddenham and various farms along the way.

Robert said "My friend Charlie helped me by also raising some money and doing the walk with me. I've also had help from my Mum and Dad for getting some more sponsors." He added "it's important to raise money for a new scout hut, because we will be able to pass the building down to other children who would like to do scouts too. It will help us have a good place to learn different things like about the RAF and staying dry too!"

The scout group currently need to raise £250,000 to build a new hut due to their old building becoming unsafe and having to be removed. They have planning permission in place to build a log-style cabin with main hall, kitchen, office and storage facilities on the site of their old building at Mendlesham Green. The building will also provide a much-needed community space that other community groups will be able to hire for their meetings, and local residents can hire for private functions.

Martyn Bryant, Group Scout Leader said "Both George and Robert have shown their commitment to our fundraising to build our new Scout Hut. They have taken the Scout & Cub motto to the letter 'Do Your Best'. Robert is a very new Cub and has only been a member since April, so has definitely shown his enthusiasm. By receiving support from our young members and their parents/carers, we will be able to fundraise more money in our quest to build our new HQ with better facilities than we had before. WELL DONE GEORGE & ROBERT."





Psalm 121: The LORD our Protector

¹ I look to the mountains; where will my help come from? ² My help will come from the LORD, who made heaven and earth. ³ He will not let you fall; your protector is always awake. ⁴ The protector of Israel never dozes or sleeps. ⁵ The LORD will guard you; he is by your side to protect you. ⁶ The sun will not hurt you during the day, nor the moon during the night. ⁷ The LORD will protect you from all danger; he will keep you safe. ⁸ He will protect you as you come and go now and for ever.

Psalm 121 is one of my favourite psalms for several reasons, it takes me back to my home town of Halifax in West Yorkshire, with its rolling hills, and the happy times I had their growing up as a child and the Sunday afternoon rambles, we had in the hills. It takes me to Cumbria and Carlisle, where I had my first pastorate, again because of the hills and mountains in that area, it also takes me to Lindisfarne/ Holy Island as a place, as the Celtic Christians would put it, a "thin place", which is a place where you become closer to God.

It is often in unsuspecting places that we find we meet with God the easiest. For some Christians during the pandemic, they have found the space and time to rediscover God, in those times away from others. Psalm 121 reminds us that God is ever watching over us even though we don't always recognise it, Psalm 121 is very much a Psalm of comfort.

We all need to find our own "thin places" to be with God, to get away from the noise, clamour and bustle of everyday life, and to refocus ourselves to what our priorities in life are. I would encourage all of you whether you have found your "thin place" or to find your "thin place", to keep rediscovering it, as we come out of this pandemic and not to lose it, but to keep rediscovering that time with God and maybe take time to read Psalm 121, and let it be a Psalm of comfort for you.

Father Philip writes...

As we watch the harvest being gathered in we should be thankful that we do not go to bed hungry. Our problem in the developed

world is that most of us have too much food. It is estimated that the butter alone, if put into supermarket-sized packets, would reach half way to the moon. I regret that stockpiling food is accepted as normal. Martin Luther King had a simple answer: "We can store our surplus food free of charge in the shrivelled stomachs of the millions of God's children who go to bed hungry at night."

In describing the things on which followers would be judged, Christ put on the top of the list: "I was hungry and you did not feed me." We are all called to share, after the example of the little boy in the feeding of the 5,000 (John 5 v 1-11). "One of the disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said, "There



is a small boy here with five barley loaves and two fish; but what is that between so many?" We know what happened next.

We support Christian Aid; we support those in need at home locally through the Stowmarket FoodBank. At Harvest we support St Martin's Housing Trust, Norwich, helping homeless people. Do we give – or do we walk away because we feel it encourages people to be lazy and 'dependent'?



St Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa) told how once in India she came across a family that had not eaten for days. It was a Hindu family. She took a small quantity of rice and gave it to the mother of the family. What happened next surprised her. That mother divided the rice into two halves and took one half to the family next door — which happened to be a Muslim family. Seeing this, Mother Teresa turned to the mother and asked, "How much will you have left over? Are there not enough of yourselves?" The woman replied simply: "But

they haven't eaten for days either."

"That," said Mother Teesa, "takes greatness." The woman's greatness consisted in being able to look beyond her own and her family's need.

A priest had just said Mass when a woman came into the vestry to say her shopping bag had been taken from the church. The priest expected her to say: "What kind of person would steal from another in God's house?" However, without a trace of anger or bitterness, she said, "Maybe the person who took it neds it more than I do."

It is easy to preach generosity, but this woman practised it. Hers was generosity from the heart.

At Mass the Word of God nourishes us in this banquet with His Body and Blood, so we in our turn are able to nourish others. Giving is not just giving things, but giving ourselves, our time, energy and love. Joy is one of the lovely fruits of generosit. Your rarely meet a



generous person who is sad – and you rarely meet a happy miser. Someone wrote: "I cannot gauge my wealth by an inventory of what is in the bank. The only valid gauge is an inventroy of what I have in my heart."

I hope we shall have a generous response to our harvest appeals next month.
