Good News.

Our Revised Plan has now moved another stage further in the required process.

You may recall that towards the end of last year, Mid Suffolk District Council appointed Janet Cheesley BA(Hons) DipTP MRTPI to carry out an independent examination of our draft modification of the Mendlesham Plan adopted March 2017. Janet decided that there was a need for further consultation with statutory consultees which was duly undertaken with Janet then continuing her work over the past few weeks. The examination was conducted through written correspondence. Locally, we had no ability to discuss or question Janet on her findings.

On Wednesday 22 June 2022, the examiner issued her final report. It recommends that, subject to further amendment, this modification draft NDP meets the Basic Conditions and should proceed to a local referendum. Further details of her findings and required amendments can be found on the Mid Suffolk District Council website as above.

At the time of writing, the required amendments to the documentation are being undertaken. We will keep you informed of the date of the referendum and update our Mendlesham web site very shortly so that you can review the amendments further to the examination report.

We intend to have a public drop in session in the Old School Room, Mendlesham:

Friday 12 August 2022 5-7pm

Saturday 13 August 2022 10am-noon.

Please come and have a look at our displays and ask questions so you know what you are being asked to support at the referendum.

Your support to attend and vote for the modification is vital to ensure after so much work, the plan can be adopted by Mid Suffolk District Council and become a legal part of the planning process and represent the local voice of Mendlesham.

The first few months of 2022 have continued to be busy at the foodbank, with people still recovering from the effects of the pandemic, taking time off work due to ill health and now the added pressure of increased fuel costs. Amazingly, although demand for the foodbank has increased each year since we started in 2012, we continue to receive donations on a regular

basis, whether it's donated goods or financial giving. This generosity and support enables us to keep the foodbank running and gives us the capacity to help more people in need. Everyone who receives a food parcel is touched by people's kindness and appreciates the fact that there are people who care.

FOOD BANK STATISTICS

476 emergency food parcels were sent out in the first quarter of 2022, which equates to 1055 people being fed in our local area. A massive thank you to all our supporters. We could not have managed to support so many people without your help.



Come on down and enjoy free tea, coffee, cake and sausage rolls, plus good friendly company.

There is also a selection of jigsaws, books and magazines to take away free of charge.



I have recently been struggling financially, and I don't know how I'm going to afford to feed my family this month. My friend told me I could be eligible for Universal Credit – is this right?

You might be able to get Universal Credit if you're not working or on a low income. You can check if you are eligible by using the webchat at citizensadvice.org.uk/helptoclaim or calling for free on 0800 144 8 444. The line is open 8am – 6pm Monday to Friday.

Universal Credit has replaced older benefits such as Housing Benefit, Income Related Job Seekers Allowance and Child Tax Credits for most people. You'll get a single payment each month, rather than weekly or fortnightly. You may be able to get extra payments if you:

- look after children,
- work and pay for childcare
- need help with housing costs
- are disabled or have a health condition.
- are a carer for a disabled person or you have a disabled child

There may also be other benefits you are entitled to, depending on your circumstances. You can use the benefit calculator to find out at gov.uk/benefits-calculators. If you need help, then Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk can do a benefit check for you.

If you are struggling to buy food, Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk can make a referral to your local food bank. They can also talk through your circumstances to see if there is other help they can provide or anything else you may be eligible for, such as help with your energy bills or school costs.

Mendlesham Over 60's Minutes of June Meeting 2022

Twenty five members attended this meeting. I started on my own as most of the committee were busy and could not attend as they had other commitments. There were several apologies. A list for a trip to Wroxham was sent around.

The speaker, Mr Colin Hopper, spoke on the history of "London Bridge".

Several London Bridges have crossed the Thames but the one he concentrated on was built in 1176 and took 34 years to build. They sank the footings in cement to stabilise the stone bridge. At 60 ft long and 20 ft wide houses were built on both sides – 12 feet was for road, 4 feet each side for houses. The houses protruded over the river and each level got bigger as they went up. Bottom floor was a shop which paid rent to the Bridge Trust. If a house caught fire it was pushed into the river so it did not spread and was rebuilt. This bridge stood for over 600 years.

The Millenium Bridge was not paid for out of our taxes but by the Bridge Trust. This was a very interesting talk and every one enjoyed it.

The competition was won by George Taylor, 2nd David Lambert and 3rd Colin Geyman.





This year as part of the United Reformed Churches celebrations for it's 50th year, they are having a hymn writing competition. This got me to thinking about how churches react to new hymns and songs.

Some would say "New Song? New song? You've got to be joking!" This is often the reaction that many worship leaders get when they have a new hymn/song in worship.

Congregations almost seem scared to try a new hymn, and do not have the confidence that they can pick it up quickly to sing it in worship. There is all something comforting about singing the familiar. (There is nothing wrong with that)

Often when I attend a meeting or conference, they have a hymn and we have no time to practice it, but it always goes well. Yes, it can be a challenge to learn it as you sing it but to me it can reflect what worship should be.

Congregations can be very resistant to new songs and hymns as their words and music take them out of their comfort zone and into frightening new territory. If we can see new songs or hymns as a metaphor for new ideas, new ways of being, new ways of relating to others and new ways of being what God has called us to be, then the challenge is clear. Worship should not always be comfortable, we need to be challenged in our worship.

Once we pick up the courage to sing a new song or hymn, like the psalm shows us then the whole Earth can open up to our senses. The focus of our worship is a strong glorious God and his words are of joy, praise and rejoicing not scepticism, fear and uncertainty. It is not about how well we can sing or follow the tune or even how quickly we can read the words, it's about recognising that all creation will laugh out loud with Joy because God is in control overall and that includes us.

God's saving work is a new song, Heaven and Earth rejoices in a new song, the fields, forest and fishes sing a new song, so let's try new songs and hymns for ourselves. Our new voices may yet surprise us.

Fr Philip Writes...

There are a number of days I want to draw your attention to this month. One of my favourite feasts is St Lawrence on 10th

August. Lawrence was one of seven deacons in Rome serving Pope Sixtus II in the cathedral. In AD 258 the Emperor Valerian ordered punishment for officials of the Church and Pope Sixtus II was put to death but Lawrence was detained in custody. The Prefect of Rome demanded that he had three days to bring him the treasures of the Church. Lawrence worked quickly, distributing treasure to impoverished people, and on the third day, instead of bringing gold and silver, as the Prefect had expected, Lawrence brought a group of poor, disabled and



suffering people being cared for by the Church, saying, "Here are the

treasures of the Church." The Prefect sentenced Lawrence to death and he was roasted alive over a slow fire on a gridiron.

One of the prayers at Morning Prayer says, "Teach us to see you present in all; help us to recognise you most of all in those who

suffer." So many people are wounded on the path of life and St Lawrence is a great example of how we should view all people with respect and care. At St Mary's the last words the celebrant says after the blessing are: "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord and to serve each other," – a good



reminder of how we should go out in the love and light of Christ.

On 12th August we shall begin our festival weekend, called "the Patronal Festival" of the Assumption of our Lady. St John's vision in the Book of Revelation (ch 12) speaks of the woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of 12 stars on her head. This is the scriptural basis for Mary's Assumption. The second reading at the Parish Mass (1 Corinthians 15 v 20 -26) affirms that Christ has been raised from the dead, "the first fruits of those who



have died. Just as all die in Adam, so all will rise in Christ, but each in their proper order" and the Church suggests the proper order puts Mary, Mother of Jesus, second after her Son.

This great feast is a reminder that we will one day die and stand before Jesus Christ, the just judge. (2 Timothy 4 v.8) The Assumption festival invites us also to pray for those who are dying.

Do we pray for a happy death? Are we ready to meet Jesus now?

As I write, we have no idea of the cost of repair but it is likely to be several thousand pounds. Added to this we have to remedy a number of electrical faults at more expense. It is 35 years since the church was rewired. All profits from Tuesday coffee mornings will go to these urgent projects and the Friends are planning more fundraising events in the Autumn.
