#### **Parish Council:**

### **Annual Parish Meeting.**

The Annual Parish Council meeting is an opportunity for the electors of the Parish of Mendlesham to meet and discuss items of interest to them. It is not a Parish Council meeting, although it is organised by the Parish Council.

In the past, for many years, part of this meeting has included awards to individuals and organisations of the Parish for their service to the community.

Unfortunately the Parish meeting due to be held in April 2020, during the first lockdown had to be cancelled due to Covid and the inability to meet in public. The Parish meeting held 20th April 2021 had to be held virtually, again for Covid reasons and the then available legislation covering public meetings, which then included the ability to meet virtually.

Whilst this virtual meeting was attended by members of the public, the decision was made to defer presentation of any awards until we could meet physically and hopefully more would be able to attend the meeting.

So with everything crossed, for Tuesday 19th April, the Main Hall, Mendlesham has been booked and provided we can meet, we will be presenting awards for the years ending April 20, April 21 and April 22. The awards will include an individual award, an organisation award plus a "one off" additional category for work for the community specifically related to the Covid emergency.

We do already have the awards that were due to be presented for the year ending April 20. Some nominations have already been received for April 21 and recognition for contributions to the community for Covid work. However, if you wish to nominate either an individual or organisation for whatever category, please can you send your written nomination to the Parish Clerk by **15th March**. If you wish to double check we have received and will be considering a nomination you have already made, please also contact the Parish Clerk by 15th March.

#### **Parish Council:**

#### **Mendlesham Community Centre Charity**

**Update:** Re the decision in principle to sell the areas of the building owned by Mendlesham Community Centre to Suffolk County Council for provision of the new SEND unit, located in what was the Small Hall, plus the Changing Rooms and 50 % ownership of the charity for the Main Hall.

#### Hire:

From 1st September 2021, community hire for the Main Hall and Changing Rooms is being managed by the John Milton Academy Trust. **Or telephone** 01449 672531 and ask to speak to the Sports Manager.

#### **Small Hall:**

This is now not available for hire by the community as it is being used exclusively to home the Mendlesham Mulberry SEND unit.

However, extensive works have been completed to adapt these premises, paid for by Suffolk County, under a Licence for Works which has now come to the end of its term and a Licence to Occupy covering the current occupation by the SEND unit.

**Sale:** Now that the Licences mentioned above are in place, legal work can now concentrate on the Sale documents including continuation of hire of the building after sale by the community and obtaining third party permissions to agree the Charity can sell.

#### New Build:

Progress has also been made with regard to the New Build.

A preferred Architect and Project Manager has been agreed, but we will not formally appoint them and start to pay fees for their work , until we know the third party permissions as required (potentially Charity Commission and Fields in Trust) are available. The aim is to ask the Architect to initially obtain planning permission which will involve further consultation with residents and potential users of the building.

We have also investigated potential funding sources in addition to the sale proceeds, and visited other village halls, asking questions of others who have completed similar builds locally and relatively recently.

#### **Communication:**

In addition to using this newsletter and E News to reach as many of you, we also hope to be able to communicate updates and news by different sources.

So much achieved, we are making progress, but still much work to do. We will let you know as soon as we have more to share.

I keep seeing on the news that my bills could be going up soon. It's making me really worried, especially as I spent more on Christmas than I should have done. How can I get my spending habits back on track in 2022?

A lot of people will be asking themselves this question right now. The good news is there are lots of things you can do to be more in control of your money and better prepared for the future.

Firstly, find out exactly what money you have coming in and going out each month. Be realistic about what you need for essentials like food and travel. Then you can set yourself a budget that you can stick to - take a look at the budgeting tool on the National Citizens Advice website to help you do this. This can be found at citizensadvice.org.uk/debt-and-money/budgeting.

If any of your bills do go up in the coming year, you can go back to our budgeting tool anytime to create a new plan and stay in control. The website also has tips on how to reduce your regular living costs which you may be helpful if you find you have more money going out than coming in at any point.

If you've been using credit cards, your overdraft or store cards for your spending, it's understandable if these debts are causing you worry. It's important to prioritise paying your rent or mortgage, plus energy bills and Council Tax. Not paying these has the most serious consequences. If you need further support on this, our advisors can explain which bills you need to prioritise and the support available for paying these and other bills. We can also make sure you're getting all the income you're entitled to, such as benefits or government grants.

All through my Ministry, and even before, People have said that the church is dying and it will not survive another 20 years! I was hearing that as a teenager nearly 40 years ago. I am glad to say that people are wrong to say this, because this year The United Reformed Church is Celebrating 50 years since it was formed, but the history of the Churches that formed it goes back to the reformation, and also 1662 when many ministers was ejected from the Anglican Church for refusing to use the 1662 prayer book.

The United Reformed Church was formally merged in 1972, when the Presbyterian Church of England, and the Congregational Church in England and Wales united to become the church. One Member of Parliament at that time described this merger as: "one of the most historic measures in the history of the Christian churches in this country." The Church expanded when The Churches of Christ joined in 1981, followed by Scottish Congregationalists in 2000.

One driving force behind the union of the Church was to form one united Christian Church, even though this has not happened we still work very closely with Churches of other traditions, and have joint Churches with Methodists, Baptists, Anglican, Moravian and many other traditions use our buildings.

Throughout this year United Reformed Churches throughout the country are hoping to hold events to mark this anniversary, and in Stowmarket and villages we hope to mark it at the Stowmarket Anniversary service in March.

The year Culminates with the United Reformed Church's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Service of Celebration and Thanksgiving. On the afternoon of Saturday 1 October 2022, at Methodist Central Hall , Westminster, London, where the Uniting Assembly of the United Reformed Church took place in October 1972, a chance to give thanks and to celebrate the five decades of the United Reformed Church.

Happy Birthday to the United Reformed Church and here's to the next 50 years.

# Fr Philip Writes...



We shall be offering Bible Studies by Zoom during February and March, based on what we can learn from the Seven Churches of Asia in the Book of Revelation. We need to hear afresh what the Risen Christ has to say to his people. It would be easy to use the tough messages to the seven churches as a peg on which to hang complaints about our village church, and I do not wish to do that. As we study the verdict of the Risen Christ on the life of first century Christians, we will see aspects of our own church life mirrored in theirs. I hope we shall hear

his challenge and take up the promise of renewal.

Today's Church is under fire from many directions – for being restrictive rather than liberating; for not responding enough to the needs of others; for being out of touch with young people; for lack of vision; for being too inward-looking. The author of the Book of Revelation knows the churches intimately and understands what they face. More importantly, Christ himself understands. He is calling them to bear witness faithfully in the face of everything that threatens them. In Revelation the number 7 symbolises completeness, so the 7 Churches symbolize the whole Church.

Each Church needs to listen to what God may want to say to it and what it can learn from God's message to others...for the particular danger which may have befallen one Church is potentially a danger for any Church.
