



Parish Council:

Co option of new Parish Councillor:

At the Parish Council meeting of 9th February, Parish Councillors had the challenging task of appointing a new Parish Councillor from applications received of the very highest quality. It is a real shame we only had one vacancy.

Dan Lummis was the successful candidate with the necessary formalities now to be completed. Congratulations Dan, thank you for applying, we look forward to working with you.

Parish Council:

Precept for 2022/23:

The Precept is the element of your MSDC Council Tax bill that comes to Mendlesham Parish Council to enable the Parish Council to provide the services that it provides for the year. Other Authorities, including the Police, Mid Suffolk District Council and Suffolk County Council set their own amounts to request from Council Tax payers as part of the Council Tax Bill.

Mendlesham Parish Council has agreed the budget and Precept for the year commencing 1.4.22. After very careful consideration, the Mendlesham Precept has been set at £44,000 (£40,000).

After changes to the Mendlesham tax base which takes into account those eligible to pay Council Tax and any changes in the number of properties in the Parish, this will mean for a Council Tax Band D property £75.38 pa (£71.23) This is an increase of 5.83% or £4.15 pa for Band D properties towards the Mendlesham Precept. We do understand that some live in properties that are not Band D and may experience financial hardship despite the property size. However Band D is the category /information commonly used when providing Precept information.

The Parish Council is extremely aware of financial constraints likely to be experienced by residents this year. However this decision was reached with reluctance, because there is a real need to maintain Parish Council spending power to help the community. The Precept was not increased last year due to unknown Covid implications and inflation is rising.

Parish Council:

Annual Parish Meeting.

The Annual Parish Council meeting is an opportunity for the electors of the Parish of Mendlesham to meet and discuss items of interest to them. It is not a Parish Council meeting, although it is organised by the Parish Council.

In the past, for many years, part of this meeting has included awards to individuals and organisations of the Parish for their service to the community.

Unfortunately the Parish meeting due to be held in April 2020, during the first lockdown had to be cancelled due to Covid and the inability to meet in public. The Parish meeting held 20th April 2021 had to be held virtually, again for Covid reasons and the then available legislation covering public meetings, which then included the ability to meet virtually.

Whilst this virtual meeting was attended by members of the public, the decision was made to defer presentation of any awards until we could meet physically and hopefully more would be able to attend the meeting.

So with everything crossed, for Tuesday 19th April, the Main Hall, Mendlesham has been booked and provided we can meet, we will be presenting awards for the years ending April 20, April 21 and April 22. The awards will include an individual award, an organisation award plus a "one off" additional category for work for the community specifically related to the Covid emergency.

We do already have the awards that were due to be presented for the year ending April 20. Some nominations have already been received for April 21 and recognition for contributions to the community for Covid work. However, if you wish to nominate either an individual or organisation for whatever category, please can you send your written nomination to the Parish Clerk by **15th March**. If you wish to double check we have received and will be considering a nomination you have already made, please also contact the Parish Clerk by 15th March.

Further details and agenda will be available much closer to the time.

I've just been offered a new job and now I need to tell my current employer. The new company wants me to start as soon as possible. The problem is, we're already a bit short-staffed where I am now and I don't know how soon I'll be allowed to leave. How should I bring all this up with my boss?

Congratulations on your new role. It can feel awkward telling your current employer you're moving on. The time between telling your employer you've found a new position and you actually leaving is known as your notice period.

If you've been in your current job for less than a month, you won't have to give any notice period (unless your contract says otherwise). If it's more than a month, you'll have to give at least one week's notice. Your contract should make it clear exactly how long is expected.

If you don't have a contract, and your employer has no written record of you agreeing to a notice period, you should give at least one week's notice.

It's worth waiting until your new employer has confirmed your employment, for example by giving you a start date before handing in your resignation. It's then best to resign in writing (email is fine), so that you have a record of the date you told your employer. On the Citizens Advice website we have a section on resigning with tips on how to write this letter. This can be found at citizensadvice.org.uk/work/leaving-a-job.

You can work a longer notice than the one in your contract, if you agree it with your employer. If you're keen to move on sooner rather than later, it may also be possible to negotiate a shorter notice period than your contract says. If you want to go down this route, it can be useful to reassure your current employer that you will tackle any urgent work before finishing.

Fixed-term contracts are a bit different, as you won't need to give notice if you intend to leave on the last day of contract. Leaving early would usually mean giving at least one week's notice, unless your contract says otherwise.

Don't forget about your holiday days during your notice period. If you have unused paid holiday you should speak to your employer about either taking these during the notice period or being paid for them.

Finally, sometimes people can change their mind about moving jobs or find their circumstances alter. If this happens to you, you should speak to your current employer to see what the options are and if you can stay in your current role.

STOWMARKET FOOD BANK UPDATE no.1 - 2022

People need help from the foodbank for various reasons; sickness, victims of crime, bereavement, family breakdown, benefit issues, self-isolation etc. They contact us through referral agencies. We work with over 55 referral agencies to ensure that we are meeting genuine needs and offer additional support if needed. The demand for help from the foodbank has increased each year since we started in 2012. Incredibly this has been matched by the generosity of our supporters. During December we received donations from individuals, schools,



businesses and organisations. Many people opted to do a reverse hamper, making time over the festive period to think of others. We were able to use the gifts, food, money and Christmas goodies given to make 135 Christmas hampers. These were in addition to our emergency food parcels & enabled us to bring some festive cheer into people's lives. Those

who received hampers were touched by people's kindness.

FOOD BANK STATISTICS

1235 emergency food parcels were sent out in 2021 which equates to 2749 people being fed in our local area. A massive thank you to all our supporters. We could not have managed to support so many people without your help.

It is not normal within the United Reformed Church, to celebrate Ash Wednesday, but many other traditions do, it is very much a day of prayer, penitence, preparation, and fasting. you can often tell if somebody has been to an Ash Wednesday service, as they will have a cross of ash upon their forehead. Traditionally the ashes come from the burning of the previous years palm crosses, and is a reminder that as we came from dust we will return to dust, symbolizing our sinful nature and need for salvation.

An Ash Wednesday service can be seen as mournful, but it shouldn't be, but as a reminder of our preparation throughout Lent, reminding us of Jesus 40 days in the wilderness, preparing himself for Ministry, and as we use Ash Wednesday and Lent to prepare ourselves for Easter. This time should also be used as a time of reflection to see and hear where God is calling us to be, as we head to the joy of Easter morning.

Fr Philip Writes...



March is dominated by the Church's season called 'LENT'. This is a very special time of preparation for Easter beginning with Ash Wednesday on 2nd March. This day takes its name from the ashes put on our foreheads, which come from last year's palm crosses. We are 'ashed' for two reasons: First it reminds us that, like Jesus who died on Good Friday, we are destined to die. Second, it reminds us that if we want to rise to a new life we must convert- turn from our sins and follow

in Jesus' footsteps. Tolstoy said,

"Everybody thinks of changing humanity, nobody thinks of changing themselves." Whatever we do in Lent, we should not bring attention to ourselves. We could learn a lesson here from the stone and wood carvers of mediaeval churches and cathedrals. They never signed their art but preferred to work anonymously for the honour and glory of God.



It is helpful to look at the Gospel for Ash Wednesday – *Matthew 6 v 1-6, 16-18*, which concerns 3 Lenten disciplines:

- Giving Money
- Prayer
- · Fasting.

Giving Money



A child swallowed two coins and the mother told the father to phone the doctor. "No," said the father, "I'm ringing the Vicar; he's the best person I know to get money out of anyone!"

The purpose of giving money in Lent is not to respond to the Vicar but to respond to God. True giving is 'praying with the pocket' and sadly, the last part of many people to be converted is his/her pocket.

Let's consider: Do I give money willingly and generously, or only grudgingly and sparingly?

2. Prayer

A soldier nearly drowned when his canoe capsized near a waterfall. As water sept him towards impending death, the Lord's Prayer flashed into his mind and he began to pray. Suddenly he experienced a burst of energy and the feeling of a greater presence than himself.



He battled the water with new strength and reached safety just in time. His experience makes me ask: What about my prayerful contact with God? When was it strongest in my life? What keeps it from being strong now? Whoever has lost contact with God lives on the same dead-end street as the person who denies God's existence.

3. Fasting

I have known many people giving up sugar or cakes etc for Lent who have



prayed for it to end quickly as they were so miserable. We must fast or abstain (do without) for God and not for our own benefit – and any money saved should go to a good cause and not ourselves. Isaiah brought God's people face to face with their hypocrisy when he said they were simply observing outward

discipline without any substance.

He said: "Share your bread with the hungry! Shelter the homeless!"

So Lent is a time to examine our motives for giving money, praying and fasting. Giving money shouldn't be a display of my generosity but out of concern for others. Prayer is not offered to win approval, but as an experience God's love for me and mine for Him and fasting is to show sorrow for the sin of self-indulgence and has no value if I do it only to let others know how holy I am.

So let us this Lent contradict the words of Tolstoy and remember that if humanity is going to change, we must first think of changing ourselves.

Happy Lent!
