
MENDLESHAM CAMERA CLUB

Mendlesham Parish Council projects:

At the time of writing, we are only a few days away from the Parish Meeting on 19th April. For those of you who were able to attend, we hope that you enjoyed celebrating the great work residents and organisations undertake on behalf of the community. We also thank those not specifically mentioned at the Parish Meeting for your hard work to make the community the vibrant community it is. We will publish the report from Mendlesham Parish Council and reports as received from other organisations on the Mendlesham web site as soon as possible.

Currently, in addition to the "normal "business of the Parish Council such as planning matters, street cleaning, maintenance of our assets including allotments, playingfields at Mendlesham and Mendlesham Green and Mendlesham's Woodland we have some larger projects which continue to progress. These include:

Mendlesham Revised Neighbourhood Development Plan: This is currently subject to a Mid Suffolk District Council Reg 17 Independent Examination, notice of focused consultation ending 29 April 2022.

In July 2021, Mid Suffolk District Council appointed Janet Cheesley BA(Hons) DipTP MRTPI to carry out an independent examination of our modification draft NDP. After undertaking a high-level assessment, the examination was put on hold to allow two issues to be addressed. They relate to the strategic environmental assessment (SEA) screening process, and to missing content from the Consultation Statement. For further information see:

It is hoped that following this latest consultation, Janet will be able to continue her work and report accordingly.

Quiet Lanes Project: The posts have been installed and it is hoped the signs will be installed shortly with the intention that those roads involved will be enhanced for the enjoyment of walkers, horse riders and cyclists.

Mendlesham Parish Council projects continued:

Mendlesham Memorial Playingfields:

You will have noticed increased use of the playing fields, including for football. This is to be welcomed, not only for the well being of those involved, including children, but also spectators. The hire income provides a valuable source of income to offset the otherwise public cost of maintenance of the playing fields, children's play equipment, MUGA and Wheel Sports Area. We will be having a formal, very belated "opening event" for the MUGA and WSA shortly. The next challenge is to work towards increased formal hire for the MUGA. More details shortly.

Community Centre sale and New Building:

Work for this project continues, although at this stage there is still very little to say. An architect has been selected but not appointed because we are waiting for permission to sell and then build from Fields in Trust. You may recall that the playingfields and associated buildings and facilities were dedicated to Fields in Trust (the old Playingfield Association) for a previous Queen Elizabeth Jubilee celebration. This was to protect the playing fields for perpetuity. However, we now need to obtain outline permission for our plans. This is complicated in that we do not have finalised plans to show Fields in Trust. We don't want to spend lots of money on Architect and planning fees until we have at least a "warm" indication that we are going to obtain the required permission. This is taking time. As soon as we have something more to say, we will let you know and we will then consult with you accordingly.

Friends of Debenham Library



On Sunday 13 March at Debenham we raised just over £500 for Suffolk Libraries Day. Suffolk Libraries are a charity, and though most of the



funding comes from the contract with Suffolk County Council, other funding is increasingly important. The contract has been extended to 2023 but has to be advertised to public tender

for the following 10 years.. We sincerely hope Suffolk Libraries win the contract again, but there is no guarantee. Whereas in many counties libraries have closed during "austerity", all libraries in Suffolk are still open and some new ones have opened too.





¹⁹After the Lord Jesus had talked with them, he was taken up to heaven and sat at the right side of God. ²⁰The disciples went and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and proved that their preaching was true by the miracles that were performed.

In April we went through the ups and downs of Holy Week and the Joy of Easter Sunday, in May we celebrate Ascension Day, 26th May 2022.

The Ascension of Jesus is found in the <u>New Testament</u> it takes place after the <u>resurrection. Jesus</u> was <u>taken up to Heaven</u> in the presence of eleven of his <u>apostles</u>, occurring 40 days after the resurrection. In the biblical narrative, an <u>angel</u> tells the watching <u>disciples</u> that <u>Jesus' second coming</u> will take place in the same manner as his ascension. Both Luke and Mark's gospels gives us two brief descriptions of the ascension of Jesus, in <u>Luke 24:50-53</u> and <u>Mark 16:19</u>. A more detailed account of the Ascension into the clouds is then given in the <u>Acts of the Apostles (1:9-11)</u>.

The ascension of Jesus is professed in the <u>Nicene Creed</u> and in the <u>Apostles' Creed</u>. The ascension implies Jesus' humanity being taken into <u>Heaven</u>. The <u>Feast of the Ascension</u>, celebrated on the 40th day of Easter (always a Thursday), for many churches but not ours is one of the chief feasts of the Christian year. The feast dates back to at least the late 4th century,

The ascension is one of the five major milestones in the gospel narrative of the life of Jesus, the others being baptism, transfiguration, crucifixion, and resurrection.

It has been depicted in art work from the 6th century, and often ascension scenes were being depicted on domes of churches. Many ascension scenes have two parts, an upper (Heavenly) part and a lower (earthly) part. The ascending Jesus is often shown blessing with his right hand - directed towards the earthly group below him and signifying that he is blessing the entire Church.

In the Gospels of Mark and Luke the Ascension Story is seen as a time when the disciples are blessed, and in some ways ordained to go out and preach the good news to all. The return to Jerusalem after the Ascension ends the Gospel of Luke where it began: Jerusalem. The narrative of the <u>Acts of the Apostles</u> begins with the account of Jesus' appearances after his resurrection and his Ascension.

Whether we celebrate the Ascension or not we as Christians are always being called by Christ, to preach the good news and he gives us different rolls within His Church. Are we ready to respond to His call?

Fr Philip Writes...



MAY has always been a joyful month in nature and among people. In medieval England May Day was a public holiday and people were up at dawn to go 'a-maying'. Branches of trees and flowers were carried back in triumph to towns and villages and the centre of the procession was occupied by the maypole, decorated with ribbons

and wreaths. This month has long been dedicated to Our Lady, since people felt all this joy was connected to the joy of her motherhood. But all the glory that nature gives to God cannot compare with the glory reflected in



Mary. She proclaimed the glory of the Lord above all created things, as she gave birth to the Lord of nature. Mary is important because she is a model of faith, trust and obedience. She was the first Christian, the first to accept Jesus Christ into her life and into her body as she carried him in her womb for the salvation of the world.

The angel Gabriel tells Mary 5 things about the Son she is about to conceive:




1. His Name: He is to be called Jesus, which means 'God Saves'.

2. He will be great: No other human being has ever or will ever be born who is greater than this child.

- 3. His status: He will be Son of the Most High that is, Son of God. He is Emmanuel God made Flesh.
- 4. He will sit on David's throne: He is therefore the Messiah, the one promised to Israel to free them from oppression and lead them out of slavery into a new freedom with God.
- 5. His kingdom will never end: He is permanent.

On hearing this, Mary asks, "How can this happen? I am a virgin."



Virgins don't have babies. The Saviour would be born of Mary through the Holy Spirit overshadowing her – and that divine sonship of Jesus rests and depends on the virgin conception. Man and Divinity are brought together to save us from sin.

We sing at Christmass: 'Peace on earth and mercy mild: God and sinners reconciled.' That reconciliation takes root first in the Love of God and the Obedience of Mary. No wonder the month of May is dedicated to her!
