

For the Trustee, Mendlesham Parish Council to apply to the Charities Commission for England and Wales to sell Mendlesham Community Centre building and associated pavements to Suffolk County Council. Mendlesham Community Centre charity intends to use the proceeds of the proposed sale towards funding a new community centre in the Parish.

7pm Public meetings: There will be two public meetings as above, to count and record the votes with the help of an independent adjudicator.

7.30pm Parish Meeting.

The Annual Parish Council meeting is an opportunity for the electors of the Parish of Mendlesham to meet and discuss items of interest to them. It is not a Parish Council meeting, although it is organised by the Parish Council.

The agenda will be published on Parish Notice Boards and E News closer to the time, but will include the opportunity to discuss any matters of concern or interest from Mendlesham Parish Residents and to note any reports received from parish organisations. Any representatives wishing to submit a report, please can you contact the Clerk **as soon as possible** to confirm you wish to submit a report and then ideally do so in writing, before **Friday 14 April.** Please note written reports will be uploaded to the Mendlesham web site.

Parish Council:

4 May 2023 Elections:

The term of office for our existing Mendlesham Parish Councillors is about to come to an end, with the process for nominations and election for eligible residents who wish to stand for Mendlesham Parish Council about to commence. This is the opportunity for a democratic process to select those to represent you at a local level from 9 May 2023.

Please consider if you are able to stand. **Do not assume that all existing Parish Councillors will stand.** It is also essential that we have at least 8 Parish Councillors stand for election for the Parish Council to continue to qualify to use Power of Competence, which then enables, subject to those regulations, increased flexibility for the Parish Council to spend to support the Parish.

By the time you receive this newsletter the closing date for submitting a Nomination to stand for Parish Councillor will be close. Correct Nomination forms have to be received in person (i.e., not post or electronic means) by Mid Suffolk District Council by Tuesday 4 April 4pm. There are local opportunities to take the forms to Mid Suffolk District Council, including Mendlesham has appointments at Eye, on 22 April and 24 April for any forms to be taken on behalf of anyone wishing to stand for Parish Councillor.



Parish Council:

Precept for 2023/24:

The Precept is the element of your MSDC Council Tax bill that comes to Mendlesham Parish Council to enable the Parish Council to provide the services that it provides for the year. Other Authorities, including the Police, Mid Suffolk District Council and Suffolk County Council set their own amounts to request from Council Tax payers as part of the Council Tax Bill.

Mendlesham Parish Council has agreed the budget and Precept for the year commencing 1.4.23. After very careful consideration, the Mendlesham Precept has been set at £51,000 (£44,000).

After changes to the Mendlesham tax base which takes into account those eligible to pay Council Tax and any changes in the number of properties in the Parish, this will mean for a Council Tax Band D property £89.58 pa (£75.38). This is an increase of 18.83%, £14.20 pa or £1.18 per month for Band D properties towards the Mendlesham Precept. We do understand that some live in properties that are not Band D and may experience financial hardship despite the property size. However, Band D is the category /information commonly used when providing Precept information.

The Parish Council is extremely aware of financial constraints likely to be experienced by residents this year. However, this decision was reached with reluctance, because there is a real need to maintain Parish Council spending power to help the community.

I ordered a watch online for my partner's birthday. The company has since gone out Mid Suffolk of business. I keep phoning and emailing them but can't get through to anyone. If they don't send the watch, what should I do?

If the company has gone into administration, it may still be able to fulfil outstanding orders, but if the company is already in liquidation, you'll need to try to get your money back. If you're unsure about what state the company is in, the Citizens Advice website has information on how to find out.

As the company hasn't responded to your calls or emails, is there a shop or office you can visit or write to, to get an update on your order or request a refund? If that isn't possible, the next steps depend on whether it's a limited company (it will have ltd or plc after its title) or if it's a sole trader (someone who runs their own business) or partnership.

If it's a limited company, you'll need to get details of the administrator or receiver - the person dealing with settling the trader's debts. The names of those administrators will usually be on the website of the company that's gone bust. You should register your claim as a creditor on the GOV.UK website. Fill out the form with details of what you're owed and send it to the administrator dealing with the trader's debts. Unfortunately, there's only a small chance you'll receive any money back because you'll be last in a long list of creditors who need to be paid.

If you paid by credit card, you could also try getting your money back with a Section 75 claim to your card provider or bank. Full details about both these types of claims can be found on the Citizens Advice website. If the seller was a sole trader or partnership and not a limited company, pursuing a Section 75 is your best option.

Every case is different when traders go under, but you can call the Citizens Advice consumer helpline to find out exactly what your rights are on 0808 223 1133 or visit www.citizensadvice.org.uk/consumer







celebrations of the death and resurrection of Jesus. How meaningful are they in our daily lives? On Good Friday Jesus died on the cross. He forgave

the penitent thief and he forgives us. We simply need to accept that


forgiveness; our sins are merely a handful of dust thrown into the ocean of God's great love. We, too, are called to be people showing forgiveness in our lives. A powerful example of this comes from a lady called Corrie ten Boom, who had been incarcerated in a Nazi concentration camp during World War II. After the war she toured Europe giving talks, urging rival nations to forgive one another. One night after a talk in Munich, a man came up to her and extended his hand in a gesture of reconciliation. She recognised him as one of the most hated guards in the camp she had been in. She simply couldn't take his hand. But she prayed: "Jesus, help me – I can't forgive him!" She recounts how instantly a higher power helped her to take his hand in forgiveness. That night Corrie learned a great truth that Jesus, who taught us to love our enemies, empowers us to do this too. All we need to do is to ask for that power.

Easter is about new life and resurrection. George Orwell said, "Either life is a preparation for something greater and more lasting, or it is meaningless, dark and dreadful." Heaven is not just a continuation of this life with a few extras thrown in. Jesus made it clear there is no comparison between this life and that of resurrection. In the chapel of the Holy Cross in St Mary's (the former south porch) are four modern wallpaintings which depict some symbols of the resurrection. One of these is a butterfly. That, of course, evolved from a chrysalis, which in turn evolved from a caterpillar. Though the creature is the same throughout these three states, none of them bears any resemblance to the others, and the last state - the butterfly - is so much more beautiful than the first - the caterpillar. So it will be for us. One of the prayers in a Requiem Mass says of death: "Life is changed, not ended."

On Easter Day we bless candles for our departed loved ones at the parish Mass, praying they will be 'changed from glory into glory, 'til in heaven they take their place'... "May they rest in peace and rise in glory." As Jesus said of God the Father: "... he is God, not of the dead, but of the living; for to him all people are, in fact, alive." Happy Eastertide!
