

CHARITY EVENT

On reaching the venue in Ipswich the weather concerned me more than what I was about to do. On this British summer's day it appeared that the steady rain had no intention of easing.

I signed in, was given a number and joined the queue of people snaking their way between metal barriers. My number read 201. During the long wait I focused on my reason for being there. Completing the challenge would raise over £100 for the Red Cross Charity as well as saving face with my teenage daughter who had completed a similar event the previous year. I surmised that only in England could there be such friendly banter while standing two hours in incessant rain? A call for participant 197 shook me out of my reverie. Then 201 was called.

I moved forwards to get kitted up with a harness and flinched as the assistant pulled the straps tightly around my bum! Better some discomfort I guess than being pitched out on the descent. A hard hat and heavy duty gloves were added with instructions to follow a group of seven up a staircase to the roof top, twelve storeys high. Outwardly I was calm but aware of my increasing heart-rate. The stairwell offered temporary relief from the rain. I was shaking from the long cold wait, or was it fear? There was banter from a group of five office workmates and two friends clung to each other for moral support. I felt very alone!

Collectively we emerged on the roof of the Hospital Maternity Block, the rain continuing to punish us anew. I was led to a rig by a male guide warning me not to trip on the hazards by my feet. I kind of got the point of that! My harness was attached to a safety line while the attendant spoke reassuringly to me. He told me to look at him and walk backwards to the roof edge taking up the tension of the rope. I did as I was told. This was no time for argument or change of heart. Suddenly my heels lost ground contact. I was truly on the edge!

I was told that I was doing fine and to just keep walking backwards over the edge. I trusted the man and began walking down a vertical wall. I tentatively released the rope lock and eased downwards. My attendant called with encouragement, suggesting that I must have been fibbing about it being my first abseil as I was doing it so professionally. Buoyed by this positive feedback I released more rope and slid down a little faster albeit rather jerkily. Now I was passing whole storeys and getting braver by the minute. I pushed away from the wall and felt the exhilaration of being suspended by the ropes alone. Now I was positively flying through the air, confidence building with every floor descended. I bounced back to the wall and pushed off with my feet again. I kept the rope released longer and the descent increased in speed and thrill. Nine, ten, eleven storeys passed and then a shout from below that I was about to reach the ground. An assistant on the ground steadied me as I landed before releasing the ropes which were hauled above for the next volunteer.

"Wow! That was brilliant! Can I do it again right now?"

We've booked a package holiday to Spain. It's our first time booking this sort of getaway, and a friend Mid Suffolk recently had a terrible experience when things went wrong on a similar trip. What sort of help is available if something does go wrong?

Hopefully you'll have a lovely time but if something does go wrong with your package holiday, the National Citizens Advice website at citizensadvice.org.uk/consumer has lots of information about what to do if something goes wrong with your holiday and what compensation you may be eligible for.

Firstly, tell the company or travel agent you booked with as soon as possible. This way you're more likely to be able to get it sorted quicker. If you don't say anything until you get home, you might get less or no compensation at all.

If the holiday you went on turned out to be lower in value than the one you originally booked you can make a claim for 'loss of value'. For example you paid for a deluxe room but only got a standard one, if it wasn't sorted out at the time you can claim back the difference in value.

You can also claim compensation for any extra money you have to spend while away, for example the hotel was a bus ride away from the beach rather than across the road as advertised. This is called claiming for 'out-of-pocket expenses'. If this does happen make sure you keep all your receipts for things like bus journeys.

If big parts of the trip you booked didn't happen or services weren't provided, for example a planned two-day excursion was cancelled and no alternative was organised, you can make a claim for 'loss of enjoyment'. You can also make this claim if something happens that causes you distress or disappointment, such as the pool was closed for the whole trip.

It's worth noting that there's no strict guidance on how much you can claim for loss of enjoyment but any claim you make must be reasonable. You can't get compensation if you simply didn't enjoy the holiday or if the problem was out of the holiday company's control - like bad weather.

Check the information you received when you made the booking to see what you're supposed to get. If you don't get the service you've been promised, you may be entitled to compensation for breach of contract. You might also be able to claim from your travel insurance – check if your policy covers this.



Fr Philip Writes

Mirror, Mirror on the wall, Who's the fairest of us all?" I'm sure we all remember those words from the fairy story 'Snow White'.

The wicked queen is constantly told by the magic mirror, "You are the fairest!" until the fateful day when she hears the reply, "Snow White is the fairest!"

The angry queen tries to kill Snow White with a poisoned apple. Snow White takes a bite and falls, as if dead. By chance (and because it is a fairy story) a prince comes to the house, removes the piece of poisoned apple and Snow White is instantly restored to health. They marry and live happily ever after.

There are parallels with the Bible, for the queen can be compared with Eve, who in the book of Genesis gave poisonous fruit to Adam, from which they both ultimately died. Eve, thinking she was fairest of all, was concerned only about herself. As we celebrate the Assumption of Mary, we call her the 'Second Eve' - not because



she was selfish, but quite the opposite. When a mirror is held up to her she always reflects Jesus (the second Adam). In the passage from St Luke's Gospel which is read at the Mass on this Feast (Luke 1 v 46-55) Mary says, "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord... the Almighty has done great things for me..."

When Mary's earthly life came to an end, she was taken up into Heaven. This does not mean she never died but that she has reached her final glory, body and soul, with God in heaven,

alongside her Son, Jesus. Mary, as 2nd Eve, was always open to God, where the 1st Eve was self-centred. The 1st Eve brought death: the 2nd Eve brought life. The 1st brought separation from God: the 2nd is in complete union with God in glory.

May we see Mary as the model of what we, too, can become, if we let Christ live in us. May we reflect Jesus, as Mary did, and less of ourselves.


