"They Shall Grow Not Old" ....

Whether you are a veteran or a new-comer to Mendlesham parish, I doubt that these five young men mean anything to you. They too lived at Mendlesham Green or on the outskirts of the parish. These 5 young men paid with their lives so that we are free to live here today.

Rightly, their names were recorded on a marble plaque, on an inside wall of Mendlesham Green Baptist Chapel. When the chapel closed and was sold as a private residence, the plaque was transferred to an outside wall, at the entrance to the chapel graveyard.

Naturally, over the years, the weather has taken its toll and the lettering disintegrated. Thankfully, it has been re-lettered but at considerable cost to the small graveyard maintenance fund. This peaceful place is lovingly maintained by two former Mendlesham men, without any labour cost to the parish. Their loved ones, like mine, rest there.

Obviously machinery and fuel cost money and the memorial repair has dented the meagre balance! I did apply to the Parish Council for a grant but this was not possible. The parish originally provided land, after the war, as a Memorial Playing Field. These five young men never had the opportunity to play football there.

So, in the hope of providing some help to that graveyard fund and this memorial, I hope to hold a Quiz Night, in Mendlesham United Reformed Church, on Friday 12th. May. A contribution from the event will also be given to the URC, which is serving this parish well as a meeting place - as well as the house of God - whilst we await the new village hall.

If you are passing the chapel site at the Green, stop for a minute and see for yourself. Obviously, only a small percentage of parishioners are 'quiz people' but it would be nice to think that a few residents acknowledge what these five young men did for you and Mendlesham. Any voluntary donation will be acknowledged. Thank you.

Twenty-seven members attended our March meeting. As it was the AGM day we decided to have our speaker first.

Mr Peter Heskith's topic was "Around the world on a container ship"

After getting stranded abroad and following a break he decided to go onto a container ship as an observer.

He sailed on the Georgia which was loaded with containers. We were shown how the massive cranes locked the containers on, not only on top but also in the hold. The height of the load make the ship look very top heavy. He was allowed to go anywhere he wanted but had to inform them if he left his cabin. I recently started a new job where my boss has told me I'll have to work on bank holidays. This was never the case in my old job. Can my employer make me work on a public holiday, and should I get paid extra if I do?

When it comes to bank holidays, whether or not staff have to work is up to their employer, and you don't have to be paid more if you do. Unless your contract says you'll be paid extra for working bank holidays, you will just be paid your normal amount.

The situation will vary from job to job and may depend on a number of factors such as whether your place of work is open on bank holidays, your hours of work and crucially, what your contract says.

Take a look at your contract, if you have one, to find out what your personal situation is. Your contract might say you will always get bank holidays off but it could say you are sometimes required to work or will always be required to work. If your place of work is normally open on a bank holiday you'll probably be asked to work at least some.

Your contract might say something like: "In addition to bank and public holidays, your annual entitlement to holidays is X days". This means you get public holidays off in addition to your annual leave entitlement but it might not mean you're entitled to take the specific days off. You may be required to work a bank holiday, in which case you should get another day off instead.

Alternatively, it might say something like: "Your annual holiday entitlement (inclusive of bank and public holidays) is X days" - this means you have to take bank holidays off as part of your annual leave entitlement. Bank holidays will either be deducted from your annual leave allowance (so you'll have to book all bank holidays as paid time off) or counted as additional holiday days.

If you don't have a contract, the legal default position is that your employer can tell you when you can or can't take time off.

If you find you need to resolve an issue with your employer, first ask for an informal chat, where you can raise your concerns. If this doesn't get you anywhere, you may need to raise a formal grievance. If you need advice on this, Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk can help.



#### May is known as 'Mary's Month'.

Why do we honour Mary? Because she **heard** God's call to be mother of Jesus, and she **responded** to that call. As a result, God made man was able to be conceived in her and she brought Him into the world. We need to **follow her example** of hearing and responding to God and he will then be born in us so that we live our lives according to his will.

It is the month of the Coronation of King Charles III. We pray that he, too, will listen and respond to God's call, so God will be born in him and he will live his life and serve this country and the commonwealth according to God's will.

It is the month of the **Ascension** of Jesus into heaven. A high point in any relay race is the moment when one runner passes the baton to another runner. The Ascension of Jesus might be compared to the passing of the baton; Jesus 'passes the baton' of God's kingdom to others to continue the work he began on earth.

It is the month of **Pentecost** when the Holy Sprit of God was released in the first community of Jesus' followers, so they were empowered to 'carry that baton' – to tell and show others about the life and love of Jesus and endure the persecution of those who tried to thwart them.





May is also the month when Christian Aid week takes place. A woman saw a little girl in the street who was poorly dressed and ill-nourished. The woman was angry and said to God, "Why do you let her suffer in the world you created? Why don't you do something about it?"

God replied, "I did do something about it... I created you."

This story invites us each to say to ourselves, "How seriously do I take Jesus' command to transform our world into the kind of place God created it to be?"


Like Mary, may we hear God's will and respond to it.
