

We have listened to parishioners about the bus services that we have and many people wanted a daily service to Stowmarket. The Parish Council made a successful bid to Suffolk County Council and our new service starts on **Monday 2 منا September!!** We will still have our valued daily service to Ipswich or Eye and Diss. Buses are free for people with concessionary bus passes after 0930. For others it costs £2 per journey until December when the Government will decide if the subsidised fares can continue.

Patient Participation Group (PPG)

PPGs are UK – wide and our Mendlesham and Bacton surgeries now have one in place.

What is the Patient Participation Group?

The PPG acts as a liaison between the practice and its patients. We are an advisory group of members, who work voluntarily with the practice, acting as 'critical friends' to help to improve services for the patient population.

The group helps to ensure that the practice provides high quality care that meets the needs of patients and carers; ensuring that they put you, and improving health, at the heart of everything it does.

We are a group of people that want to help the Mendlesham/Bacton practice to work as well as it can for patients, doctors and staff.

The NHS requires every practice to have a PPG to provide feedback and suggest improvements that can be made to the services offered. It allows open discussion and an alternative perspective on the many topics relevant to general practice.

The role of the PPG includes:

- Being a critical friend to the practice
- Advising on the patient perspective and providing insight into the responsiveness and quality of services
- Encouraging patients to take greater responsibility for their own and their family's health
- Carrying out research into the views of those who use the practice
- Regular communication with the patient population

We aim to regularly review feedback and to consider areas for improvement, such as:

- Patient and carer priorities and issues
- · Themes from complaints and suggestions
- Planned practice changes
- Care Quality Commission (CQC) related issues
- The GP patient survey and bespoke surveys
- Working with local commissioners (CCG/NHS England/Local Authority)
- Views from local voluntary and community groups, including the Friends of Mendlesham Medical Group and Healthwatch

Who is part of the PPG?

Currently, our PPG consists of six patients from the practice, together with clinicians and administrators.

Times Past:

"With the recovery of the Mary Rose and her Tudor treasures at a cost of millions of pounds, it is interesting to recall the act of preservation around 400 years ago at Mendlesham which safeguarded similar relics - at a cost of 16 pence. Since the late 12th Century, every free man was supposed to possess weapons which had to be inspected from time to time and there could be a levy of men, aged 16 - 60, when needed. Later, this responsibility for the provision of troops was extended to individual parishes and from the time of Edward II, who reigned from 1307 to 1327, every parish was required to furnish a soldier or soldiers fully equipped for home service. The first soldiers would have been knights, who formed the military system of the day. One such knight was John Knyvet who in 1371 married Joan, daughter of Sir John Botetourt, Lord of the Manor of Mendlesham, also a Lord Chancellor. The arms of Knyvet and Botetourt can be seen on the spandrels of the west door of Mendlesham Church and inside the knight is portrayed on a memorial brass, dressed in a fine example of armour of the Lancastrian period.

As time went by, although each village had to produce a certain number of armed men each year, the type of man conscripted differed greatly from the early knights. They were everyday working men and their function was rather as part of a defence force rather than armies on active service overseas. The home defence force - this militia, as it was called in Elizabeth 1 time, could be likened to the Home Guard. The necessary armour for these men seems invariably to have been kept in the church, in town and country parishes. The room over the porch, which was by this time rarely wanted for its original purpose - as the priest's dwelling or, as seems more likely, as a store for church valuables - was often turned into a well stocked armoury. Mendlesham Church was no exception and the use of this chamber for the storage of armour dates back to 1593. It was imperative that this armour be readily accessible since the threat of Spanish invasion hung over England for the first 30 years of Elizabeth 1's reign.

The first known benefactor was Robert Cake. In 1476 his bequest of a 150 acre farm in Mendlesham Green was exceedingly generous as the average farm at that time was barely 30 acres.

When Robert Cake passed away in 1476 his will was primarily drafted to help fellow taxpayers of Mendlesham lumbered with 10% and 15% tax of their income by Edward IV. Any surplus to be divided equally between the church and the poor.

Over the centuries there have been further gifts of land and property to the trust and various land sold.

Throughout the last 547 years, this trust has continued to help the people of Mendlesham and Mendlesham Green.

The changes might be confusing and worrying to some people who have already factored WFP into their household budget.

That's why Citizens Advice Mid Suffolk is on hand to offer their top tips on affording energy bills this winter.


There are also steps those still entitled to the Winter Fuel Payment can take to make sure they don't miss out on this much-needed support. We know a third of people entitled to Pension Credit aren't claiming it, and it's more important than ever to apply for this benefit if you can.

Pension Credit is a weekly benefit to boost your income and is based on how much money you have coming in. If you have reached State Pension age, you might be able to apply for it. Check the Citizens Advice website to see if you're eligible and get instructions on how to apply.



Fr Philip Writes

I am devoting this entire article to our parish church.

In the Old Testament the Temple was a place where God

was seen to dwell and to be worshipped. The Christian Community also has a Temple. St Paul, writing to the first Corinthian Christians, says, "Do you not know that you are the Temple of God with the Spirit of God dwelling in you?... God's Temple is holy and you are that temple." (I Cor.3 v 16-17) Each individual Christian and especially the Christian Community, is where God lives.

Over 1,000 years ago our forebears built the first 'Temple'in Mendlesham – the parish church - for Christians to gather and worship God. We are blessed with this very beautiful building at the heart of our village – undeniably a sacred space - and the most important historical building in the parish, whether you are a Christian or not.

As well as continuing with the important Armoury Facelift Project, we have recently been told by our architect that the nave roof of St Mary's is now in need of replacement. The

costs are likely to be in the region of £0.5M, and in the near future we will have to apply for funding from a Lottery grant towards this. However, we will still need to raise a proportion of the cost in the village. How can we start to do this?

Half the proceeds go to our parish church's restoration fund and the other half to the Suffolk Historic Churches Trust. The SHCT helps churches and chapels all over the county and in due course we will need to apply to it for a grant ourselves.

discarded in the armoury in the 1870s. We want to discover whether any of the unresearched documents cast further light on the arms & armour.




